DESIRED OUTCOMES

At the end of the presentation, attendees will be able to:

- evaluate evidence generated in the past 2 years about the management of type 2 diabetes.
- incorporate into practice a greater focus on lifestyle interventions, with increased emphasis on weight loss and obesity management, including metabolic surgery.
- incorporate into practice greater focus on patient related issues and self-management which have a major impact on success of any pharmacological interventions.
- evaluate preferred choices of glucose-lowering agents driven by new evidence from cardiovascular outcomes trials and consideration of areas of major clinical need (for example weight and risk of hypoglycemia).
- prepare to assess cultural diversity issues in risk, incidence, prevalence, disease burden, or mortality associated with type 2 diabetes and/or cultural disparities in access, diagnosis at more advanced stages, or less adherence to treatment regimens.
